WHAT IS SAFE AT HOME?

Safe at Home is a statewide address confidentiality program and free mail-forwarding service that provides victims of actual or threatened abuse, stalking, trafficking, and/or those who fear for their physical safety with a legal substitute address to be used for both public and private purposes. The intent of Safe at Home is for those who fear for their safety to be able to maintain a private, confidential home, work, or school address and prevent future harm.

Participants must reside at a location in Wisconsin that is unknown to their abuser and may not disclose their actual address to the abuser.

Participants must also create a safety plan with a Safe at Home designated Application Assistant.

ELIGIBILITY

Individuals may enroll in Safe at Home if they are any of the following:

- A victim of an act or threat of domestic abuse, child abuse, sexual abuse, stalking or trafficking.
- A parent or guardian or a person who is a victim of an act or threat of abuse.
- A resident of a household in which a victim of an act or threat of abuse also resides.
- A person who fears for their physical safety or for the physical safety of their child or ward.

SAFETY PLANNING

Before applying, applicants must first participate in free safety planning with an Application Assistant. Application Assistants are designated by Safe at Home to provide individualized safety planning and education about meaningful participation in the program.
